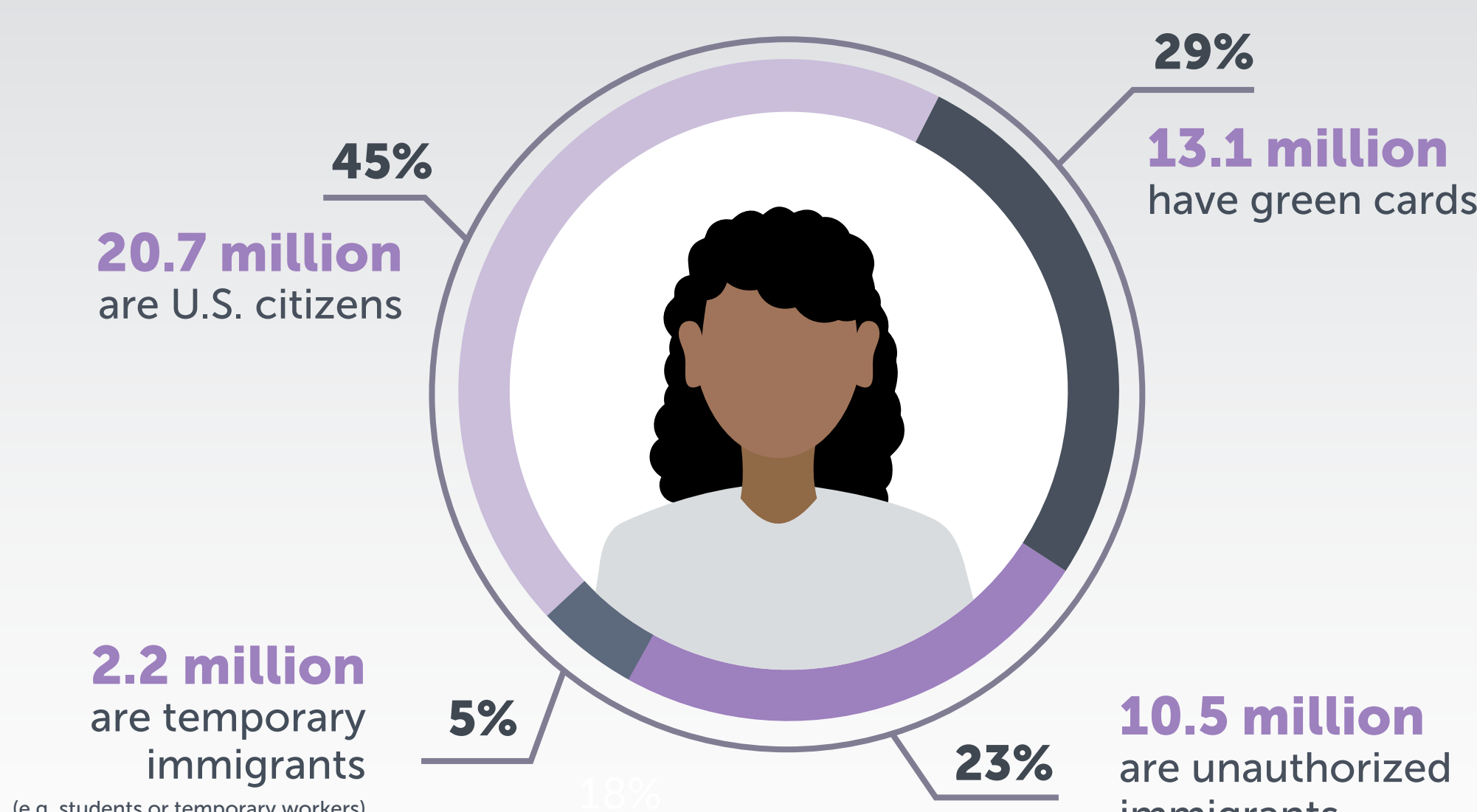


The Big Picture

There are **45 million** immigrants or foreign-born persons in the U.S.



Number of refugees arriving in the U.S. has varied in past 8 years, from **85,000 to 13,000**.



90% of immigrants have **religious faith**



The Religion Factor

7 of the 9 national organizations that resettle refugees in the U.S. are **faith-based**



- Over 30,000 congregations** have programs to help immigrants
- Faith-based organizations help immigrants on the Southern border, providing them **food, water, shelter and, other life-critical necessities**
- Faith-based organizations also provide help around the country, offering **ESL classes, jobs-training, childcare, clothing, housing and, legal services**
- Religious organizations provide aid and support** to displaced people of all faiths, cultures, nationalities and, ethnic backgrounds.
